Description:

“I, Martin Baugh citizen of Giles County, Tennessee state, aware of the uncertainty of life, do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore by me made. My first wish and desire is after my decease, that all my debts be paid out of my estate or soon as it is practicable, Secondly it is my wish and desire that my wife Harriot B. Baugh have the entire possession of my farm whereon she now lives with all the stock of every description all the household and kitchen furniture with every species of property I may die possessed of with the exception of one sorrel filly known by the name of Fly which I have heretofore given to my son John not to be accounted for in any division hereafter for the maintainance of herself and her three minor children, John, Rebecca and Harriot. John until the age of twenty one years and Rebecca and Harriot until they marry or voluntarily quit the family, it is my desire that all the property after paying my debts as above named be kept together by my wife Harriot during her natural life and at her death the land and every species of property to be sold and an equal division of the proceeds between all my children, namely Thomas C. Baugh, Wm. M. Baugh, Elizabeth Anderson, Edwin H. Baugh, Mary Brooks, Rich'd D. Baugh, Martha Tarpley, Arch'd. Boling Baugh, Rebecca Baugh, John O. Baugh and Harriot Baugh, and it is my wish that my wife Harriot B. Baugh be my Executrix to carry into effect this my last wish and desire as far--- her power lies in testimony of which I hereunto subscribe my hand and affix my seal this fifth day of February one thousand eight hundred and forty two
