[1906 newspaper clipping: Original church was erected 1798 half mile north of Shiremanstown by German Reformed Congregation formed some years before by Rev. Anthony Hautz. In 1865, the Lutheran congregation erected a new brick building adjoining the stone church, which was named St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church.]

PENNSYLVANIA 1795-1895, by David M. Gilbert (Harrisburg, PA: Harrisburg Publishing Co., 1895)

- p. 10:

“The Lutheran and Reformed people of Harrisburg united in building the first church of the town in 1787, on Third Street below Chestnut, and occupied it in common for a number of years.”

“In 1795 Zion congregation received its first regular pastor, and its records, separated from the [Salem] Reformed [Church], date from that year ...”

- p. 17:

Pastors of Zion Church:

1. Henry Moeller, 1795-1803
2. John D. Peterson, 1803-1812
3. Frederick C. Schaeffer, Nov 1812-Jun 1815
4. George Lochman, 30 Aug 1815-10 Jul 1826

“During the administration of Mr. Peterson, extending from 1803-1812, there were seventy-eight persons confirmed, nineteen of who, though confirmed in Harrisburg, belonged to a congregation in which he preached in Cumberland county.”
