"This Indenture made ... this 7th day of November ... 1828 between CATHARINE ELLIS, L??INICK MANDEL and NELLY MANDEL his wife of said LEDINICH and heir of THOMAS ELLIS decd of Sumner County and state of Tennessee of the one part and ADAM CLINE of Allen county and state of Kentucky of the other part ... in consideration of the sum of \$400 ... convey unto him the said ADAM CLINE ... parcel of land ... being in the count of Allen, state of Kentucky on the waters of Little Tramell and the middle fork of Drakes creek and bounded ... state line near the road leading from Scottville to Nashville ... containing 150 acres ... and ??? on a grant from the state of Kentucky to THOMAS ELLIS No 15832 ... Test: JOHN BORDERS, JOHN DOWELL Signed: LOEINIK MANDRELL, NELLY (x her mark) MANDRELL ... recorded July 17, 1831"

"This indenture made and entered into this 21st of October 1857 between Martha Harrison, wife of Thomas Harrison decd, and Wily G. Harrison, Elizabeth Harrison, Mariann Graves, James Graves, Peter Travelstead, Elvira J. Travelstead, Mitchell Clyne, Henrietta Clyne, Anderson Graves and Elizabeth Graves all of Allen Co., Ky. and Andrew Jackson Harrison and Elmirah Harrison of the county of Sumner and State of Tennessee, heirs of Thomas Harrison decd of the first part and R. B. Walker of the county of Allen and State of Kentucky of the second part. Witnesseth that the Parties of the first part for and in consideration of One Hundred and forty dollars in hand paid before this date have Bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and Convey into the said R. B. Walker and his heirs a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Allen and State of Kentucky on the Waters of the middle fork of Drakes Creek and Bounded as follows (to wit). Beginning at a Black oak on B. J. Gaines line, then N17 W89 « poles to a Black oak then on same course 3 « poles to a stake in H. S. Anthony's line 8 feet east of a white oak marked from aft thence with his line N69 E66 « poles to a White oak thence S36 E84 poles to . . . A. B. Walker his heirs and assignees forever and the said parties of the first part doth covenant and agree to forever warrant and defend the title to the afore said land from the Claim or Claims of all every person or persons. Whatsoever Claiming by through or under them and against the Claimer of persons lawfully Claiming the Same in Testimony of all which the said party of the first part have hereto set his hand and seal this day and date first on the proceeding page with
